

Online Synchronous Learning

Learning activities that take place "face to face" in real time via videoconferencing

"... actual time spent on the task such as watching a live lecture or video as a group then engaging in whole or small group guided analysis and reflection." (GBHEM)

A course can't be 100% synchronous

Online Synchronous Learning

- "Segments should be 120 minutes maximum and should be layered with presentation or video lecture, discussion, and breaks." (GBHEM)
- Segment length designed to avoid "Zoom fatigue" and consider the adult attention span.

Synchronous Learning: Some examples "Live" lectures Discussion Group work Demonstrations Exams

Online Asynchronous Learning

- Coursework that you complete online on Course Connect at a time you choose within a timeframe set by your instructor
- A course cannot be 100% asynchronous
- Coursework before, between, and after synchronous sessions
- Examples
 - Interacting with classmates and instructors through forums (discussion boards)
 - Watching videos
 - Viewing recorded lectures
 - Listening to podcasts

Before calling in to Zoom or WebEx

- Minimize background noise
- Turn your phone to silent or vibrate; do not place it near your computer or tablet
- Get family off the internet

Before calling in to Zoom or WebEx

- Sit facing a window (natural light is better than artificial)
- Prop your laptop/tablet on books so that you are looking directly into your camera
- Do everything you would do before an in-person class—go to the bathroom, have a drink nearby, prepare your space

When you get on the call . . .

- Turn on your video
- Turn off your microphone (only unmute when speaking)
- Locate the participant box (make sure your name appears the way you want it to; if it doesn't, edit it)
- Locate the chat box

During the call . . .

- Use nonverbal response functions to get the teacher's attention for a question
- Use the chat function




Signing in to Course Connect

 - The password for first-time users is Majors1890!


Course Connect Sign-in




Course Connect Dashboard
